

## We propose that:

- Parking during the day would remain free
- We will always allow access to vehicles in the overnight parking areas for those returning after the last bus has gone (eg in a taxi or by cycle)
- The overnight spaces will be protected by additional security measures, like fencing, barriers and CCTV
- Overnight parking is not for oversize vehicles (such as campervans) and nobody will be allowed to stay in their vehicle overnight

We're keen to know if you would use overnight parking and hear your views on the best way to introduce it.

## When will it happen?

We aim to complete the improvements in Spring 2026, with no major interruption to bus services during the works.

## Have your say:

York's buses are benefitting from £17.3m of government funding. We're using this money to deliver a range of improvements, from bus priority measures to new shelters, seating and lighting. We now want your views on our proposals to improve the Park and Ride sites, including Askham Bar.

Our plans include converting five existing EV bays into accessible EV charging spaces. We will also install LED lights across the site, upgrade signage, CCTV and ANPR cameras, and install new accessible cycle parking plus a parcel locker. We will also install a defibrillator.

## Overnight parking

- Overnight parking would be a paid-for service
- Overnight parking will give residents and visitors a chance to leave their car safely and securely and avoid having to drive into central York for a late evening or overnight visit
