






## Have your say:

York's buses are benefitting from £17.3m of government funding. We're using this money to deliver a range of improvements, from bus priority measures to new shelters, seating and lighting. We now want your views on our proposals to improve the Park and Ride sites, including Monks Cross.

- Our proposals for Monks Cross include converting a number of EV charging spaces into Blue Badge holder only EV bays.
- We'll also offer new accessible cycle parking and a cycle repair stand.
- We'll replace and upgrade the cycle lockers and introduce micro-mobility / e-scooter parking.
- We will also repair and replace some of the block paving along pathways, and replace kerbs with drop kerbs to improve accessibility.
