Overnight parking

As well as daytime parking, we want to introduce overnight parking at Rawcliffe Bar. This will give residents and visitors a chance to leave their car safely and securely and avoid having to drive into central York for a late evening or overnight visit.

We propose that:

۲

- Overnight parking would be a paid-for service. Daytime parking will remain free
- We will always allow access to vehicles in the overnight parking areas for those returning after the last bus has gone (eg in a taxi or by cycle).
- Overnight spaces will be protected by additional security measures, like fencing, barriers and CCTV.
- We're keen to know if you would use overnight parking and hear your views on the best way to introduce it.
- Overnight parking is not for oversize vehicles (such as campervans) and nobody will be allowed to stay in their vehicle overnight

When will it happen?

We aim to complete the improvements in Spring 2026, with no major interruption to bus services during the works.

York's buses are benefitting from £17.3m of government funding. We're using this money to deliver a range of improvements, from bus priority measures to new shelters, seating and lighting. We now want your views on our proposals to improve the Park and Ride sites, including Rawcliffe Bar.

- Our proposals at Rawcliffe Bar will bring improved Blue Badge holder parking spaces.
- We'll also deliver upgraded cycle lockers, improved cycle parking, a cycle repair stand and new micromobility parking.
- Other improvements include improving signage and site security, plus replacing all lighting with LED bulbs.
- Oversized parking will still be available for larger vehicles like motorhomes, to be parked during the daytime only.
- We also propose to upgrade the existing building, refurbishing the toilets and improving the waiting area.
- We'll also construct a new canopy, connecting the building and waiting area so there's more covered space to help shelter people waiting for the bus.
